

**CHARITY CONDITIONS FOR THE TEMPORARY  
MARKET/CAR BOOT SALE  
INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS**

The following conditions apply:-

1. The Licences permits the Licensee to hold the event described on the application.(No more than six events in any twelve month period and no more than one per month, this being the maximum permitted at any venue).
2. The Licence Fee is £20.00 plus 50p per car boot or stall.
3. The venue shall be used solely for the purpose of a car boot sale/temporary market in connection with the named charity.
4. The stalls/cars on the site shall not be used other than in connection with the fund raising activities of the operator and no other organisation.
5. **THE ONLY PERMITTED GOODS SHALL BE THE SECOND HAND GOODS OF HOUSEHOLDERS** together with any goods owned by the registered charity.
6. **No** Commercial or Market Traders shall be permitted.
7. The Licensee shall ensure that adequate off Street Parking arrangements are available.

8. Events held on a Sunday or Bank Holiday should not commence before 10.00am and 9.00am on other days.
9. The Licensee shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that adequate off street parking arrangements are available.
10. The Licensee shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that no nuisance or annoyance is caused to occupiers of property in the vicinity of the site or members of the general public.
11. The Licensee shall be responsible for the payment of any rates or other outgoings in respect of their occupation of the site.
12. The Licensee shall indemnify the Council against all claims whatsoever arising out of the use of the site.
13. The Licensee shall comply with all Enactments relevant to the use of the site.
14. The Licensee shall comply with all Enactments relating to any restrictions on the sales of goods on Sundays.
15. The Licensee shall give to the Council all notices required by section 37 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1982.
16. No flammable gases e.g. hydrogen, shall be used or sold for the purpose of inflating balloons or other similar apparatus.

17. The Car Boot Sale/Temporary Market shall comply with the Food Hygiene (Market Stalls and Delivery Vehicles) regulations 1966.
18. The Licensee shall ensure that adequate toilet and hand washing facilities are available for people attending the Car Boot/Temporary Market.
19. The maximum display area of any stall/pitch shall be 16ft by 16ft.
20. The Licensee shall ensure that any advertisement for an approved event shall include (“Licensed by the regeneration Department”).
21. The Licence is not transferable.
