

BLACKBURN WITH DARWEN BOROUGH COUNCIL COMMONS ACT 2006 (Schedule 2)

The Commons Act 2006, Schedule 2(4), to register waste land of the manor not registered as common land

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by The Open Spaces Society and The British Horse Society to Blackburn with Darwen Borough Council concerning land at Hoddlesden Moss, Near Darwen,

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: At the time of the application the land is considered to be waste land of a manor. The land was provisionally registered as common land under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965, as the result of a rights application, objections were received and subsequently an agreement was made to cancel the registration.


