

## Nisai Course List – 2020-2021 Academic Year

### EXAM/Qualification Requirements

**Please note: The Customer must provide the student with a local Examination Centre which can meet their needs prior to their being enrolled in their exam year with Nisai. Nisai will require confirmation that this has been agreed and appropriate contact information.**

**Students without an Exam Centre will not be enrolled in their exam year until a centre is confirmed.**

Please note that Nisai strongly recommends an Exam Centre is sourced prior to referral; there is no requirement for local exam centres to support a private candidate and enrolling a student without an Exam Centre is a risk.

The candidate's Exam Centre is responsible for all aspects of summative assessment including entries, access arrangements, scheduling, authenticating, supervising and marking.

Customers should work with the candidate's Exam Centre to ensure that appropriate arrangements are in place for their students and that Nisai is provided with the relevant information from access arrangements to exam results. This includes ensuring the Centre is approved for the correct awarding body and qualifications.

Please note for non-examination assessments, controlled assessments and spoken language/practical endorsements, students may need direct supervision from the Customer or Exam Centre.

Exam Centres may wish to delegate marking of written assessments to Nisai. Please enquire directly with the exams officer to see if this can be arranged. The Exam Centre should also ensure that this is permitted by the awarding body. Spoken language, practical endorsements and all non-exam assessments with AQA must be completed by the Exam Centre.

Nisai will provide students with the resources to be adequately prepared for the examinations and for all summative assessments and will provide Exam Centres with relevant information to support accurate examination entries.
