

Blackburn with Darwen Council Privacy Notice: Breathing Space Mental Health Crisis Debt Moratorium

Service area – Adult Social Care (Mental Health)

Purpose we collect the data

Breathing Space Mental Health Crisis Debt Moratorium is a debt respite scheme. It provides protections for people who are resident in England and Wales who are in problem debt. The protections include pausing enforcement action and contact from creditors and freezing interest and charges on certain debts. This service is available for people receiving mental health crisis treatment and offers protections which lasts as long as a person is in mental health crisis treatment, plus 30 days.
