

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE PLEASINGTON PARISH COUNCIL, HELD AT THE CLOG AND BILLYCOCK, PLEASINGTON, ON 29th OCTOBER 2019

- PRESENT Councillor Marrow in the chair, Councillors Caton, Green, Griffiths and Isherwood and it was nice to see quite a number of residents.
- APOLOGIES 3019 There were no apologies
- DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST 3020 There were no Declarations of Interest .
- MINUTES OF LAST MEETING 3021 It was RESOLVED (proposed JG seconded JC) that the minutes of the last meeting, held at Pleasington Golf Club, Pleasington, on 19th August 2019, having been read by the Clerk, be received and approved.
- ACCOUNTS TO DATE 3022 The accounts to date, cash books etc were presented to the meeting for inspection, and it was RESOLVED (proposed JG seconded JC) that these be accepted, subject to audit.
- ACCOUNTS 3023 It was RESOLVED that the following accounts be paid (proposed JG, seconded JC) : Clerk's salary and expenses £360.00
- AUDIT 3024 The Clerk had written to formally thank Alan Cottam for his work as our internal auditor. There had been no queries or feedback on the accounts.
- PLANNING 3025 There were no objections to a planning application at Bucklow House. At Brownlow Farm mention was made of an alteration to the roof line on the original house and roof lights that were not in the previous planning application. The Clerk to ask the Borough to investigate.
- LALC EXEC COMMITTEE 3026 The Clerk had attended meetings of the LALC executive committee at County Hall (representing the Blackburn Area committee). There had been a presentation by Clive Grunshaw, the Lancashire Police and Crime Commissioner, The LALC AGM is to be at County Hall, Preston On November 17th and it was RESOLVED (proposed JG seconded JC) that the Clerk attend to represent the Parish Council.
- CORRESPONDENCE 3027 The Council had received a "NALC Draft Code of Audit Practice". The Council had no comments to make.
- SAFER PLEASINGTON 3028 There had been a "walk-through" through the village, attended by Borough Councillor John Pearson, and representatives from the Safer Pleasington Group and the Borough Council. Various problems were pointed out, especially around the Walk Mill Bridge and Railway Bridge areas. It was hoped that some action would be taken in the near future.
- CIRCULARS 3029 Information from LALC, plus various magazines and Circulars, was presented to the meeting and it was RESOLVED (proposed JG, seconded JC) that this be accepted for information purposes.
