How long we hold the data

Register of electors - Until superseded then 1 copy archived
Registration Correspondence/Rolling registration/Correspondence - Current year plus 2 years
Application forms/Absent voting/Proxy Forms - Whilst relevant plus 1 year
Personal Identifiers list - To be kept up to date
Nomination papers - 1 Year
Local Ballot papers - 6 months after election
