## **Legal basis for processing**

Legal basis for processing of personal data for the purposes of Channel is set out in Article 6(1)(e) GDPR: the processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller. Clause 8 of the Data Protection Bill provides that Article 6(1)(e) includes (a) processing of personal data that is necessary for the exercise of a function conferred on a person by an enactment or rule of law, and (b) processing of personal data that is necessary for the exercise of a function of the Crown, a Minister of the Crown or a government department. It is necessary for the purposes of the various Channel duties set out in Section 36 of the Counter Terrorism and Security Act 2015.
