To equip the children and parents with the tools and coping strategies to be prepared in the event of an emergency situation and to enhance self-resilience within our community

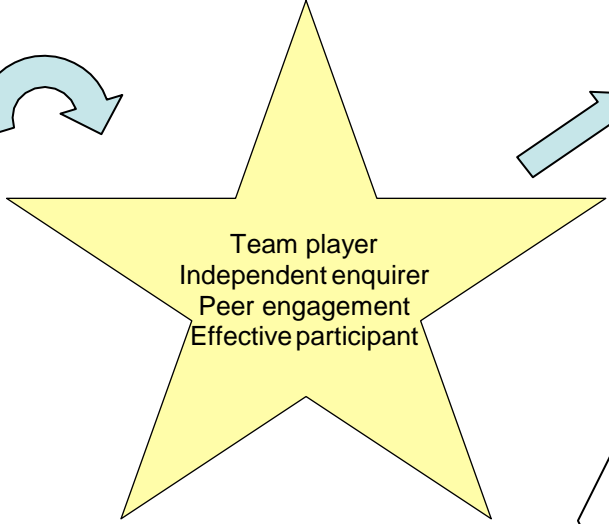

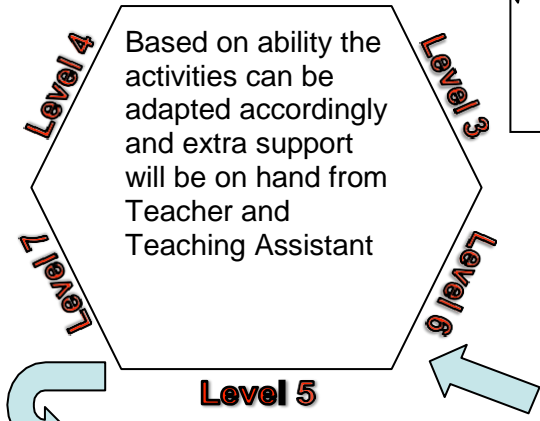

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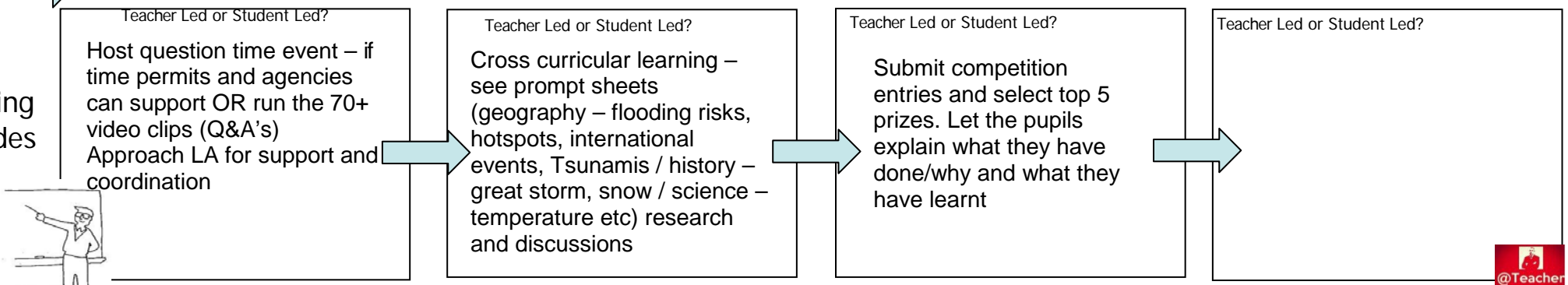

# SESSION FIVE



- *Cross curricular learning opportunity* – prompt sheets (Geography - where would you choose for a rest centre, flooding risks and hotspots, International events Tsunamis etc. History – Great Storm, East Coast, snow, Science – Temperatures, Art – logos, Literacy and Numeracy)
- *Submit competition entries* – teacher to select top 5 winners (2 grab bag prizes and 3 smaller gifts) [Teachers could extend this to week 6 if more time is needed]
