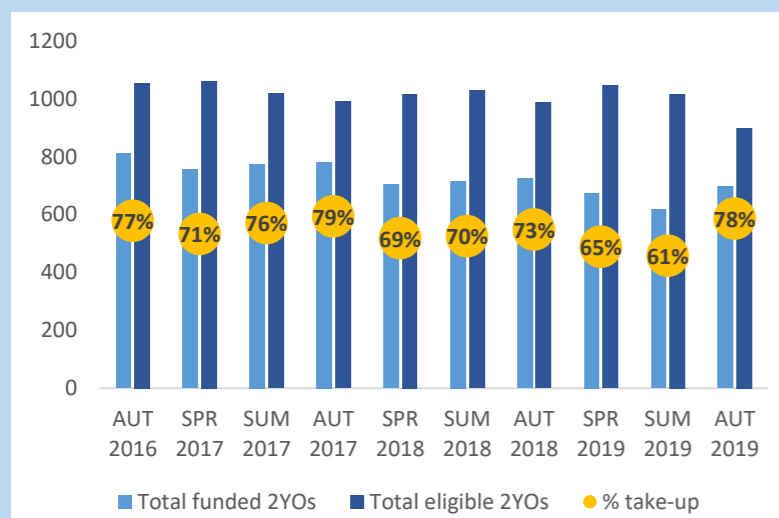


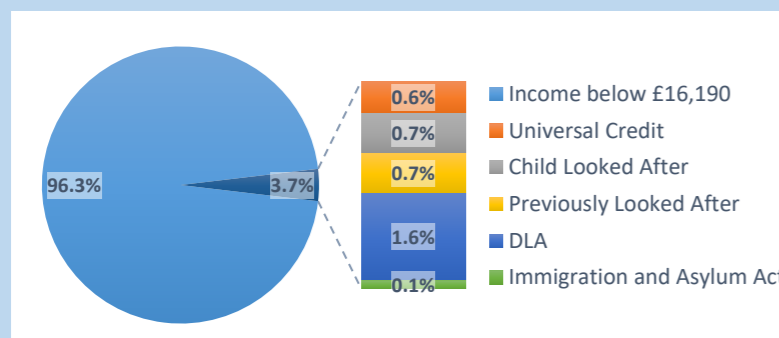

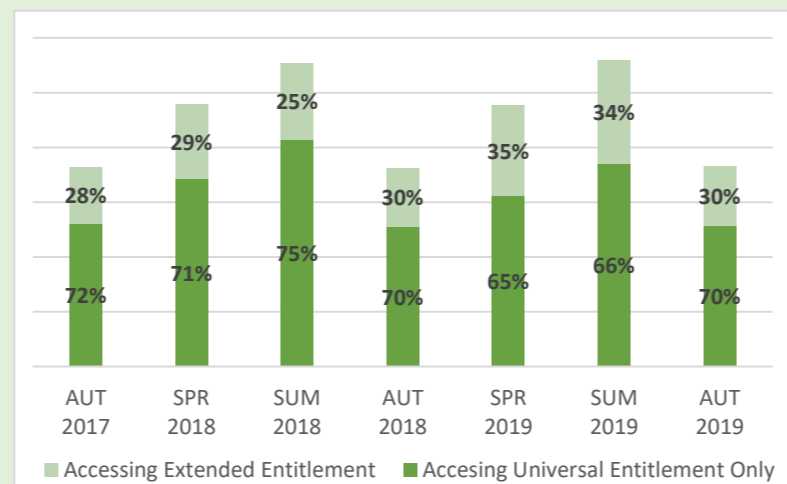

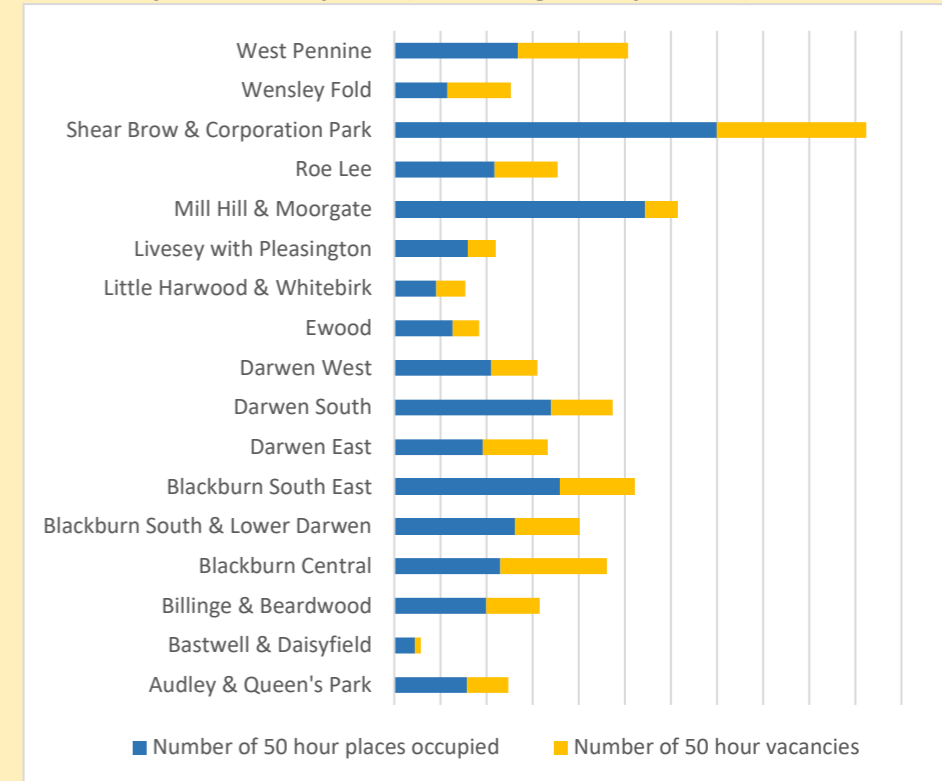
Percentage of the total funded 3&4YOs accessing universal and extended entitlement*:
