- ❖ There had been a complaint by a resident of parking along the Chapel Wall. The Chairman had contacted the resident, but no further communication had taken place.
- ❖ There were problems with the drains near the bridge at Longhey Lane.
- ❖ There was a strip of land that led to a portacabin that the council used that was in need of repair. There was an informal agreement that the council would make good the land, but this had not happened. The clerk would chase up the request for repair.
